



JNP Covid Policy Update – 5

August 31, 2022

Isolation and Quarantine Guidance and Protocols

- **Quarantine** for asymptomatic exposed children is no longer required.
- **Mask use** is optional for all at JNP, if you want your child to wear a mask indoors, please inform us by email and we will follow through with your request.
- **Children who have had a close contact** may continue to attend as long as they remain asymptomatic.
 - Should your child become symptomatic at any time after an exposure, we will test them if enrolled in the RAT program and we still have tests remaining. If not they will be sent home for testing.
 - We are recommending that exposed persons test on Day 6 if possible.
- **Children who test positive** must isolate away from JNP for 5 days. If they are asymptomatic or symptoms are resolving and they have been fever-free for 24 hours with no meds. They may return after Day 5 provided they meet the above and following criteria:
 - If the 2+ year old child tests negative on Day 6, they may return without wearing a mask
 - If the 2+ year old child still tests positive, they must wear a mask through Day 10 or until a negative test is obtained.
- **Symptomatic children** may remain at JNP if they test immediately onsite and test is negative. We recommend they wear a mask until symptoms resolve.
- **If symptomatic children cannot be tested immediately**, they will be sent home. They may return if:
 - They test negative and symptoms are resolving and manageable.
 - Have been fever free for 24 hours with no meds and symptoms have resolved.
 - A medical professional deems them cleared in writing, to return to JNP.



- **Children under 2 years of age**, who test positive for Covid:
 - Will need to isolate away from JNP for 5 days
 - Children may return on Day 6 with a negative test and they are asymptomatic, able to participate and they have been fever-free for 24 hours with no meds.
- **Children under 2 years of age:**
 - **Although the FDA does not recommend rapid tests for this age group**, antigen tests may be used off-label, if they are asymptomatic, have completed a 5- day isolation, or had an exposure, parents may administer a test and submit the negative results to us by email.
 - Should your child become symptomatic within the 10- day time frame, we will send your child home for further testing.
